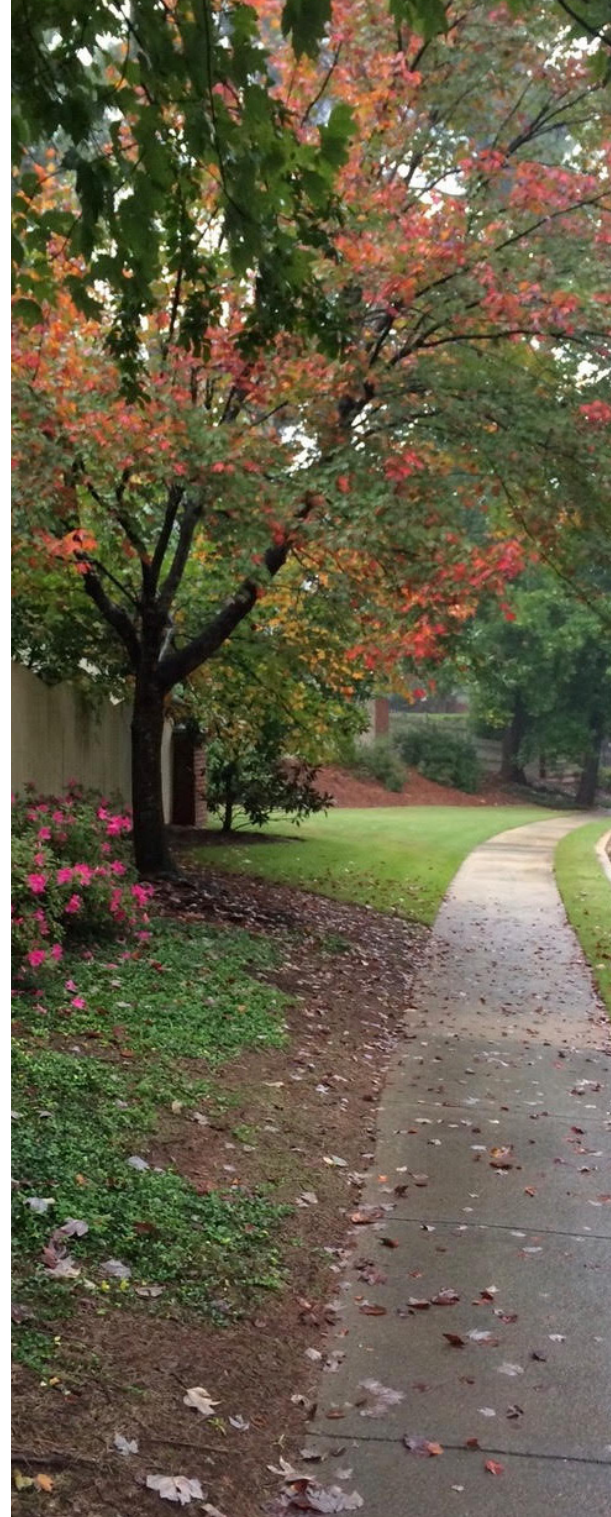

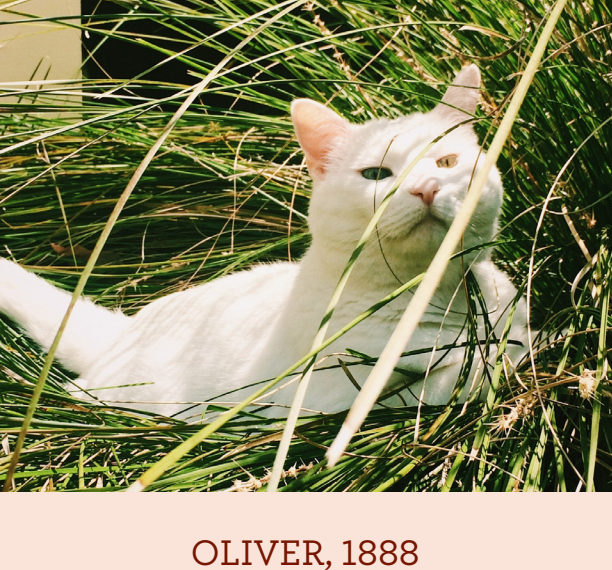
**Creatively:** Help with the Fox Chapel Connection, form groups for music, books, bridge, other interests.

Dr. Saba Kahn was recently a Fellow in Nephrology, and she is now a physician at Southern Crescent Nephrology.

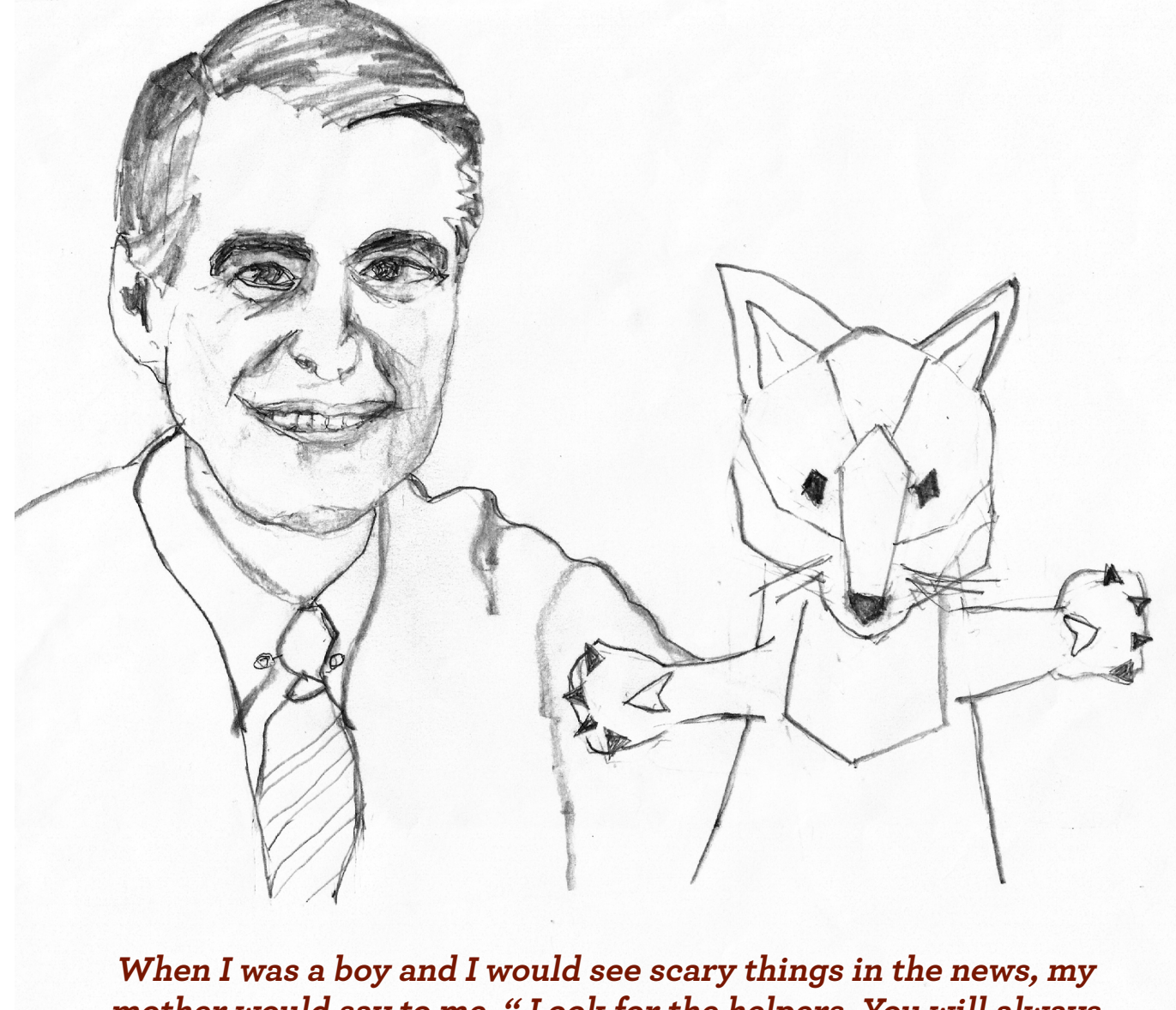
Erica Smith, a pediatric nurse practitioner at Children's Healthcare of Atlanta, specializing in Endocrinology.
